A direct debit is an automatic transaction that transfers money from your account to another.

Direct debit payments are considered a type of 'account-to-account' payment method. When you set up a direct debit, you authorise a merchant or service provider to take an agreed amount of money from your nominated account using your BSB and Account Number, or your card number, CVC and expiry date. Direct Debits are set up with the supplier.
